EMERGENCY SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT SET TO BEGIN ON WEST OLNEY ROAD

June 6, 2016

The City of Norfolk Department of Utilities has hired Inner-View Construction to begin an emergency project as soon as possible to replace collapsed sanitary sewer pipes on West Olney Road, between Duke and Boush Streets.

The project will replace the sanitary sewers on the north and south sides of West Olney Road, beginning at the intersection of Duke Street and ending at the intersection of Granby Street. The 1970s-era water main on Olney Road will also be replaced while the road is opened for the sewer construction.

Due to the complex nature of working alongside the many other utilities under this section of roadway, the project, which will include a new asphalt surface, is expected to require until the end of 2016 for completion.

Water and sewer services, as well as access to businesses will be maintained throughout the project. The City and our contractors will do our best to minimize the unavoidable disruptions associated with the construction.
