Sanitary Sewer Pipe Installation Planned on Boush Street

Dear Valued Customer,

The City of Norfolk Department of Utilities has hired TA Sheets to install a sanitary sewer pipe on Boush Street, between Freemason Street and Charlotte Street, as shown on the map to the right.

Construction is planned to begin at the end of June and is planned for completion by early August 2016.

Sanitary sewer service will be maintained throughout construction, and neighborhood access will be maintained with through-traffic detours around the work zone.

The City and our contractor will do our best to minimize the unavoidable disruptions associated with construction.
