



Water & Sanitary Sewer Infrastructure Improvements Underway in Fairmount Park Neighborhood

Dear Valued Customer,

The City of Norfolk Department of Utilities' \$3.5 million infrastructure improvement project is currently underway in the Fairmount Park neighborhood. The project area is shown on the map to the right.

The City's contractor, Peters and White, is continuing work which began in March 2016 and is on schedule to finish in the spring of 2017. To date, sanitary sewer main has been installed in Kitchener Ave., Lens Ave., and Pope Ave. Water main has been installed in Pope Ave. and Kitchener Ave. Storm drain has been installed in Kitchener Ave. For the next few months sanitary sewer, water, and storm drain installation will continue in Verdun Ave. and Lens Ave.
