
## Water Pipe Replacement Planned on Miller Store Road

Dear Valued Customer,

The City of Norfolk Department of Utilities has hired TA Sheets to install approximately 1,700 feet of new water pipe along Miller Store Road, as shown on the map to the right.

Work will begin in January 2017 and is planned for completion by early June 2017.

Vehicular access will be maintained with through-traffic detours around the work zone. Water service will be maintained throughout construction. Businesses will be notified in advance of short-term service interruptions associated with new water system tie-ins.




The City and our contractor will do our best to minimize the unavoidable disruptions associated with construction.
