Water and Sewer Infrastructure Improvements


Planned in the Titustown Neighborhood (Phase 5)

The City of Norfolk Department of Utilities is planning a project to replace aging water and sanitary sewer infrastructure in the area shown on the map to the right.

This multi-phased project will include survey, design and construction of new water and sanitary sewer pipes, as well as resurfaced streets.


The City's consultant, Gannett Fleming, has been hired to complete the project's design. Over the next few months, survey crews may need to access the exterior of your property in order to identify property boundaries, easements and surface features. **At no time will they request to enter your home or business.**



This project is currently in the design phase and construction has not yet been scheduled. We will provide you with updates and information before construction begins.
