Cecelia Street Sewer Main Replacement

Dear Valued Customer,

The City of Norfolk Department of Utilities has hired Innerview, Ltd. to replace the aging sewer main on Cecelia Street between E. Virginia Beach Boulevard and Corprew Avenue, as shown on the map to the right.


This emergency project is anticipated to begin in early January and is expected to be completed within 2 months. Work will include the installation of new sanitary sewer pipes and a resurfaced street.

Sanitary sewer service will be maintained throughout construction. Neighborhood access will be maintained with through-traffic detours around the work zone.

The City and our contractor will do our best to minimize the unavoidable disruptions associated with construction.
